

CELEBRATING JOAN

Dorothy Joan Williams, always known as Joan, had a heart for the Word of God and the work of the church in the world. Joan, born in Melbourne in 1926, moved to Canberra to work in the Bureau of Statistics as a young woman. Her work included setting up a census in Papua New Guinea. A Uniting Church woman, Joan ended up worshipping at Holy Covenant Anglican Church in the last years of her life. To her friends she was witty, kind, generous and loyal. These traits resulted in long standing friendships, some lasting and more.



Joan loved cats, cryptic crosswords and her holidays down the South Coast. Her support for the mission of the church continued to the end. Before she died, early in 2019, Joan arranged a purchase of children's Bibles, youth Bibles and adult Bibles for those attending her funeral service and to be given to those who would care to have one. Her funeral was a joyful celebration of her life.

In the last few years of her life, Joan became interested in Andrea's work with Embracing Ministries and she asked Andrea to be sure to take some Bibles for the children and families with whom she worked.

Family Service

This month at the Family Services, we had a guest speaker, Karen Baron from Christian Education in Schools (CEIS).

Karen spoke about CEIS and its work to bring Christian education into public schools in the ACT.

ACT legislation allows for there to be Christian education inside of school if parents request it. Once the request has been made, CEIS works with the school and the ACT Education & Training Directorate to provide Christian Education once a term. This work is done with support and help of volunteers in our community.
