## **The Holiday Programs**

In 2019, the Spring Program for youth with a disability and the Little Treasures all-inclusive program for Primary age children were both wonderful experiences.

At the Spring Program, the young mentors from colleges around Canberra, have already spent 2 days training with staff from ASPECT and learning key sign language and developing a basic understanding of disability before the program begins. There were some great activities each day such as a visit from the Reptiles, Music outreach program and access to a great range of bikes which were a very popular choice.



The young people with disabilities were placed in small groups according to their needs and were able to join for whole group

activities or choose to spend some quiet time with their support person. Every effort was made to ensure familiar faces were there to greet the young people with disabilities each day and friendships were formed. There was a wonderful feeling of sharing, acceptance and togetherness during the program.



The Little Treasures program is an all-inclusive program with 25 children without disabilities and 15 children with disabilities. The team put in so much thought and preparation before the program, ensuring a fun daily program. Flexibility is built into the program with a high ratio of volunteers to children, particularly for those with disabilities, so that the children may repeat an experience they enjoyed, check out what others are doing, join in for whole group activities or spend some quiet time while still building relationships in a safe, relaxed environment.

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#### A Mentor's Story

I first heard about the Embracing Ministries Spring Program when Andrea came to speak at my church, St Mary in the Valley in Calwell. She showed us photos and explained all about their ministry. I was so moved by the stories of the kids, I knew I had to be a mentor on the upcoming Spring program.



I love kids, and have considered teaching as a possible career in the future. I also have a passion for God and sharing his love that I knew I could bring to the program however I was a bit afraid. In my 17 years of life I really had much hadn't experience with disability or people with special needs. I was nervous to be surrounded by kids with whom I didn't really know how to interact, whether it be because they aren't very verbal, aren't as physically active or mobile, or think and perceive the world in ways I could not relate to and comprehend. I was nervous but I knew I wanted to do it and it would be a great experience. I am so grateful for the training we as mentors received before the program, as I learnt so much about how to communicate

differently, from understanding the science of the brain, to kids with autism and using key sign language. From the first day, I was still learning from the more experienced friends around me but I had such fun with the kids and thoroughly enjoyed every day. I particularly loved helping lead dancing and singing for the kids songs - it was amazing to participating, watch them singing the songs they knew and engaged in the fun storytelling of classic Bible stories. Before the program I thought I was going to be a blessing, showing God's love to these kids I hadn't met vet, but it turned out the other way round. Those kids and the time I spent with them have blessed and changed me forever. I can't wait to see them again and continue in this beautiful ministry led by Embracing Ministries.
